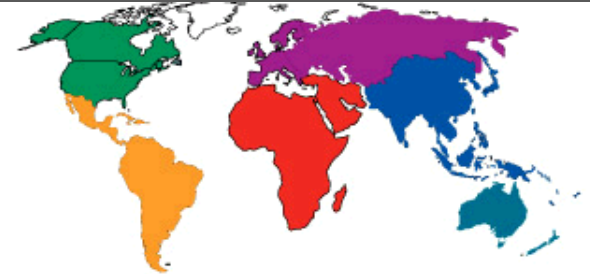

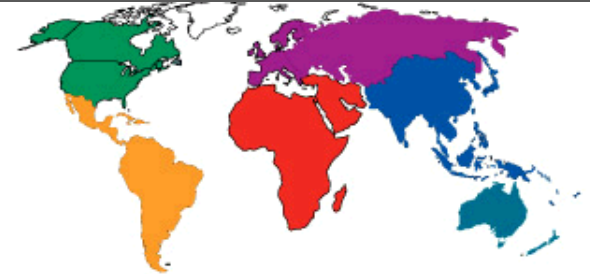

Description: You are invited to join us in Schwerin, Germany, on a very active exchange for ambassadors who love nature and culture. We are inviting friends from all over the world to explore Schwerin and its vicinity by bicycle!

Schwerin, the capital of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, lies in the wonderful scenery in the north of Germany between Hamburg and Berlin, close to the Baltic Sea. You can fly to Schwerin via Hamburg and take the train for the last part, where your Schwerin host will pick you up and take you to your new home for the week!

After a reception by the mayor, we will explore the old town of Schwerin with a guided city tour. Then we will visit the beautiful fairytale-like castle located in the middle of an island in lake Schwerin. A boat ride on the lake will end the day and be the highlight of our welcome party!





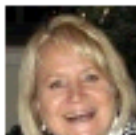
